

Brief Overview of 'The Weekender'

Barry Hilton and some of 'The League of Augsburg' Chaps are running 2 Fantastic 'Weekender Games' in Derby in 2012. One game will be a [Napoleonic Game – 23/24/25 March 2012](#) and the other, a [Grand Alliance/War of Spanish Succession \(1700's\) Game 12/13/14 October 2012](#). The Napoleonic Game will use Barry's *Republic to Empire* rules and The WSS Game will be using Barry's *Under the Lily Banners* rule set. Each game is strictly limited to a maximum of 16 players (8 'aside') and you will join your Hosts for:

Friday

Arrive Friday night and 'book in' from 6.00pm. Guests meet up (usually in the bar!) Around 8.00/8.30pm 'Your Hosts' introduce everyone. After general pleasantries, all aspects of the game are discussed – rules, scenario, commands, figure allocation etc, etc. followed by a 'Game Briefing'. Around 10.00pm you are welcome to descend on the bar to discuss with Friend and Foe alike, the coming battle!

Saturday

Breakfast. 9.00am Start Gaming. Stop for Lunch around 1.00pm. Continue gaming from 1.45pm until around 6.30pm when we break for Dinner. More gaming from 7.30pm until 9.00pm when we call it a day (nightfall!). All are then welcome to spend the evening as you wish but from experience, most people will 'retreat to the bar' – your hosts included!

Sunday

Breakfast. 9.00am start gaming until 12.15pm. Break for 'light bite' lunch. 12.45pm resume gaming final (decisive?) actions, until approx 3.30pm.

Umpires to then give 'Battle Result' and award any prizes (if deemed appropriate!).

Once payment has been received and funds have cleared, you will receive a Booking Confirmation Form and details of how/when balance of payment is due.

Terms and conditions.

(1) Deposits are non refundable. If balance payment of Weekender is not received by due date shown on 'Booking Confirmation Form' then 'The Organisers' reserve the right to 're-advertise your booking' and the deposit paid will not be refunded. We reserve this right to cover any associated costs we have or could incur.

(2) If you pay a deposit and if, **more than 16 weeks prior** to your chosen Weekender, you have to 'cancel' your booking, then you will be able to 'transfer' your deposit to any other 'Derby Weekender' (subject to availability). If you do not wish to 'transfer' your deposit to another Derby Weekender then the deposit will be forfeit entirely.

(3) If, once you have paid your 'full balance' (within 12 weeks of the actual date) of your Derby Weekender and you are then unfortunately unable to attend, then the following conditions will apply:

(a) 'The Organisers' reserve the right to retain up to 100% of your payment if we are unable to 're-sell' your booking to cover any/all associated costs we have or could incur due to your cancellation. If we are able to 're-sell' your booking, then the £180 ('Final Balance' portion) of your booking will be refunded. We will also *consider (similar to (2) above)* the ability for you to transfer your *£50 deposit* to another Derby Weekender – subject to any costs we have or could incur in the 're-selling' of your booking. If you do not wish to 'transfer' your deposit to another Derby Weekender then the deposit will be forfeit entirely.

(b) Any cancellations must be in writing and can be sent either by post or email to 'The Organisers' at the addresses already given in this document.

(4) If 'The Organisers' have to cancel any Derby Weekender events for whatever reason, at any time, up to and including or during The Weekender itself, then a full refund of £230 (per person) will be given. We will not be liable or held liable or responsible for any associated costs whatsoever, that you may have incurred prior to, during or after, the Weekender itself.

Once your 'full payment' has been received a 'Final Booking Confirmation' will be sent to you.
